

We need to let you know what has been happening at the Celebration Age Centre over the last few weeks. At the moment, the general public cannot access the building, due to water coming through the roof and other issues. The Council are planning to replace the roof and after that will be reconfiguring the inside of the building. All this work could take up to 2 years. In the meantime, we will not be able to have any classes or workshops in the building. All our equipment will have to be removed and we are working on that. If anyone knows of a room, we could use in the meantime please let us know. We will be continuing with our online Zoom sessions and if you require any help, again contact us and we will get a Tutor to help you. We will still be there for you but with a few changes in 2022. Our tutors are taking a Christmas break and Hamilton SeniorNet will be starting again in February 2022. We will contact you again early next year.

Due to Covid the SeniorNet Committee have had to think about how we can operate next year in a manner that will allow both our members and tutors to be safe. The committee have agreed that in order to do this, we will expect all members coming to a classroom to be fully vaccinated and to wear a mask. Hand sanitizer will be available for all to use and you will need to either scan or sign in when entering the classroom.
